Notice for inviting Expression of Interest (EOI) for conducting studies for National Meat and Poultry Processing Board (NMPPB).

1. Background

The Government of India launched a National Meat and Poultry Processing Board (NMPPB) on 19th Feb 2009. The formation of National Meat & Poultry Processing Board has been notified in the Gazette of India Extraordinary vide notification no 127 dated 20th January, 2009. The National Meat & Poultry Processing Board has been registered on 26th March, 2009 under Societies Registration Act, 1860. The Board started functioning from the leased accommodation at 7/6, Association of Municipalities & Development Authority, Sirifort Institutional Area, August Kranti Marg, New Delhi.

The National Meat and Poultry Processing Board is an autonomous body and having 19 Members including CEO of the Board. This apex body is launched to work as a National hub for addressing all key issues related to Meat and Poultry processing sector for the systematic and proper development of this sector. The Board would serve as a single window service provider for producers/manufacturers and exporters of meat and meat products, for promoting & regulating the meat industry, as a whole and it would result in large number of employment opportunities. It would also help the rural farmers for increasing their income.

The Board will also help industry to utilize slaughterhouse waste materials, set up quality control laboratories for meat and meat products, promote meat manufacturers to adopt Good Manufacturing Practices (GMP), Hazard Analysis and Critical Control Points (HACCP) systems, ISO-9001: 2000 standards, help industry to create and disseminate data, train workers and technicians and work as a central and National hub to address meat-related issues.

Objectives of the Board

The mandate to set up a National Meat & Poultry Processing Board is to oversee the growth and further promotion of Meat and Poultry sector in the country. This has been considered necessary because of a felt need for a focused intervention in meat and poultry sector.

NMPPB will address issues related to production of hygienic, safe and wholesome meat and meat products, including:

- Lay down policies for healthy development of the meat and poultry sector
- Evolve standards of hygiene and quality
- Harmonization of domestic standards with international standards
- Address current environmental pollution issues
- Organize capacity building efforts
- Capacity-building to address human resource development issues
- Develop uniform and effective national meat quality testing systems and laboratories
- Provide help for setting up of training institutes to train workers, technicians, managers in meat and meat processing industries
- Provide thrust on research and development for production and marketing of innovative and new value-added meat products for domestic and international markets

- Serve as a 'one-stop' service for producers and manufacturers and exporters of meat and meat products
- To undertake market surveys and help the industries to create market intelligence, database and its dissemination on regular basis for improvement of the meat sector
- Promote meat manufacturers to adopt Good Manufacturing Practice (GMP), Hazard Analysis and Critical Control Points (HACCP) systems, ISO-9001: 2000 standards in meat production and processing
- Helping the industry in setting up/modernization of abattoirs by providing technical consultancy for production of hygienic meat and meat products and for utilization of slaughterhouse wastes to prepare animal by-products with value addition
- Promote and regulate the meat industry for increasing exports
- Help industry to establish sustainable and viable commercial projects

Need to establish NMPPB

- Meat and Livestock are the major source of income and employment to very large number of families in the urban and rural areas. These apart from providing nutrition being rich in protein, generates gainful employment in the rural sector as well as endow with raw material, by-products such as hides and skins, blood, bone, fat, etc for utilization. Thus, there is a strong need to explore this potential sector.
- The meat consumers are becoming more and more aware and demanding for meat and poultry products processed in clean and sanitary environment and “convenience items” such as semi cooked, ready-to-eat, ready-to-cooked meat food products. So this separate body will cater to these upcoming issues.
- Creating more awareness regarding utilization of animal waste materials for processing into by-products.
- Training the meat workers to observe sanitation and hygienic requirements while handling meat in slaughterhouses, processing plants and consumer/retail outlets.
- Need of strict laboratory testing of meat and meat products to ensure that they meet the food safety standards. Modernization of quality control laboratories is also required.
- A focused approach and intensive efforts are required to address the issues related to production of hygienic, safe and wholesome meat and meat products; harmonization of domestic and international standards and also to address the arising environmental issues.

2. Scope of work

NMPPB intends to engage the agencies for conducting the following studies:

- (i) **Bench Marking of Abattoirs** with details of technologies/equipments & costs for four sizes of Abattoirs
- (ii) **Greening of Meat Processing Sector**-The study will cover 2 new and 2 old Abattoirs and meat as well as poultry processing units of Large, Medium and Small sizes in the public sector and also in the private sector to identify the wastage of resources, manpower, energy and suggest ways and means for optimal use of resources. It will also prepare an action plan for introducing HACCP/ISO/GMP/GHP in the meat industry (including Abattoirs) and for earning carbon credits.
- (iii) **Quality Issue in Meat Sector**-The study will cover 3 old and 2 new units of meat and poultry processers as well as 2 old and 2 new Abattoirs to diagnose the

Quality issues for Domestic as well as International market. It will make a clear cut action plan for addressing the Quality issues within next five years. It will also prepare a Blue Print Booklet for Large, Medium and Small units on these matters.

(iv) **Socio-economic Upliftment of the Meat Workers (Butchers)**-The study will cover meat workers in five Minority Concentration Districts in five different zones of the country. It will clearly bring out the present conditions of Living, Habitat, Literacy, Schools, access to Hospitals, access to modern education, skill level of Men/Women, their health conditions, economic conditions, etc. and prepare a DPR for the Socio-Economic upliftment of these meat workers including provision of civic amenities e.g. roads, drainage, sewerage, piped water supply, school building, dispensaries, upgradation of skills, organising women into SHG's for starting new economic activity, etc.

3. Eligibility of the Agency

- (a) The agencies should be well experienced in meat and poultry sector and well versed with the subject.
- (b) The agency should have a minimum three years experience in conducting such evaluations/ studies at various levels – national, state and district levels.
- (c) The agency should have executed at least one similar project for various Central/State Govt. departments/organizations. The agencies having executed similar project for Government of India/State Government/any other similar organization would be given preference.
- (d) Should have a minimum annual turnover of Rs. 5.00 Crores (Rupees Five Crores) during the last three years, to be supported by audited Balance Sheets, P/L A/c, Receipt and Payment A/c.
- (e) Should have adequate technically and managerially qualified and well-experienced in-house resource base and a strong creative team for designing and implementing the studies.
- (f) The agency should have the ability to collect relevant data/information required for the purpose without imposing any responsibility on NMPPB.
- (g) The applicant must have service tax registration and should be income tax assessee.
- (h) The applicant should furnish an undertaking to the effect that the firm has not been black listed in India or abroad by any Government department/agency.

Thereafter, the Technical bids shall be evaluated by a Technical Evaluation Committee constituted for the purpose. After evaluation of the technical bids based on the procedure given in Para 7, all the bidders shortlisted on the basis of their technical bids would be requested to make a detailed presentation regarding their qualifications, experience and the proposed Concept and Plan before the Selection Committee on 08.5.2010 at 11.00 AM in Ministry of Food Processing Industries, Panchsheel Bhawan, New Delhi-110049.

7. Evaluation

The procedure of evaluation of the applications is given as under-

- (1) 70% of weightage shall be given to the technical bid (planning and implementation process) and 30% to financial bid. The technical bid will carry maximum marks of 100. The maximum mark for each activity of technical bid is as under:

(2) The financial bids of only those Consulting agencies will be opened who score minimum of 50 marks in the technical bids. The cost evaluation will be done under Combined Quality cum Cost Based Systems and the bidder who scores highest marks will be selected.

8. Time Period and Payments

The entire work planning should be completed within six months from the date of assigning the work. A penalty of 1% will be imposed on each week's delay in work. The terms of payment would be as under:-

- ⇒ 10% as advance on award of work against a Bank Gurantee.
- ⇒ 20% on satisfactory design of the evaluation parameters, survey methodology, evaluation proforma, etc.
- ⇒ 30% on submission of draft Report.
- ⇒ 40% on submission of final report and its acceptance by the Board.

9. Technical Presentation

Once the technical bids are evaluated, the shortlisted agencies may be required to make a presentation before the Committee on 08.5.2010 at 11.00 AM so constituted for the purpose.

10. Amendment to EOI

At any time prior to the last date of receipt of bids, the NMPPB, may for any reason, whether on its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective bidder, modify the EOI document by an amendment. In order to provide prospective bidder reasonable time in which to take the amendment into account in

preparing their bids, the NMPPB may at its discretion, extend the last date for receipt of bids and/or make other changes in the requirements set out in the invitation to EOI.
