Meeting of the Food Processing Education Council (FPEC) was held under the Chairmanship of Minister for Food Processing Industries, Smt. Harsimrat Kaur Badal. The meeting was attended by Shri K. The Minister emphasized the crucial role of education and skill development in the future of the food processing industry which is expected to play a catalytic role in the growth story of India. One of the suggestions made by the experts was the need to include courses on food processing, nutrition and food safety in school curriculum.

Ministry of Food Processing Industries is working closely with the industry through Food Industry Capacity and Skill Initiative (FICSI) under FICCI on skill development. FICSI has selected Ernst & Young to develop National Occupational Standards (NOS) for the food processing industry.
