

**Minutes of the Inter-Ministerial Approval Committee (IMAC) meeting held on 5<sup>th</sup> April, 2018 to consider the proposals received under Creation/ Expansion of Food Processing & Preservation Capacities (CEFPPC).**

A meeting of the Inter-Ministerial Approval Committee (IMAC) was held under the Chairpersonship of Hon'ble Minister, Food Processing Industries on 5<sup>th</sup> April, 2018 at 4.30 PM in Panchsheel Bhawan, August Kranti Marg, New Delhi. The agenda notes for the meeting were circulated among all the members on 04.04.2018. The list of participants is at **Annexure-I.**

2. At the outset, the Hon'ble Minister, FPI welcomed all the members of IMAC to the 2<sup>nd</sup> IMAC meeting held for consideration and approval of proposals as recommended by Technical Committee (TC) which considered the proposals under the Scheme of Creation/ Expansion of Food Processing & Preservation Capacities in its meetings held on 22.02.2018, 09.03.2018 and 03.04.2018.

3. Initiating the agenda of the meeting, Shri Ashok Kumar, Joint Secretary informed to the members that Ministry had invited Expression of Interest (EoI) which was uploaded on website on 29.12.2017 and published in Newspapers on 14.01.2018 for creation/ expansion of the food processing units with last date as 15.06.2018. As per the condition in EoI, the applications received in response to the EoI would be clubbed and evaluated together at the end of the each month and sanctioned subject to fulfilling eligibility criteria and meeting the minimum qualifying assessment criteria as per the guidelines. The PMAs have evaluated the proposals received in the month of January, February and March, 2018. TC had undertaken evaluation of these proposals on the basis of presentation made before TC By the PMA.

4. While discussing the agenda of the meeting it was brought to the notice of Chairperson, that in the last meeting of IMAC held on 17<sup>th</sup> January, 2018, decision on 49 proposals from Uttar Pradesh (UP), was deferred since these projects are located in non-Mega Food Park locations. At present "In-Principle" approval for setting up of three New Mega Food Parks at Mathura, Mirzapur in Uttar Pradesh was accorded on 21.12.2017 and at Gautam Budh Nagar on 15.01.2018. Therefore, IMAC was of the view that considering of the proposals from non-MFP locations of UP may not be apt since Ministry has approved three Mega Food Parks (MFP) in UP. As per the decision of IMAC, the matter was referred to the Ministry of Law & Justice to seek legal opinion. Ministry of Law & Justice, Department of Legal Affairs, vide its I.D. note no. 298231/Adv.B/2018 dated 21.03.2018 has provided its opinion that the issues referred by the administrative Department are neither the legal issues nor interpretation of law is involved

therein. Therefore it calls for administrative decision and administrative decision may be taken at appropriate level. In view of the above opinion of Ministry of Law & Justice, Department of Legal Affairs, the agenda placed before the IMAC to solicit appropriate decision on the 49 proposals received till last date (i.e. 15.10.2017) from Uttar Pradesh State in response to the EoI uploaded on website on 31.07.2017 and published in Newspapers on 02.08.2017.

5. Hon'ble Chairman of the IMAC has sought individual opinion of the members of the committee regarding their view for consideration of the proposals received from UP as explained in the meeting. Member representative of NITI Aayog opined that till last date i.e. 15.09.2017 there was no MFP in UP by the closing date of EOI and even today final approval has not been accorded to any MFP, therefor these proposals received from UP, outside the MFPs may be considered. The member representative of Ministry of Agriculture was also of the opinion that the Mega Food Parks wherein "In-Principle" approval issued will not be operational shortly. It may take atleast two years or more to be operational. Further it has been emphasized that in past also some of the Mega Food Parks were cancelled even after final approval for not complying with the conditions in the guidelines. Therefore, it was opined by the members that proposals of UP received against the EoI dated 31.07.2017 may be considered by the IMAC as per recommendation of TC on the individual projects. Hon'ble Chairman acknowledged the deliberations on the matter and sought the details of the proposals recommended by the Technical Committee.

6. It has been informed to the IMAC that total 49 proposals received from UP State out of which 14 proposals are eligible proposals and remaining 35 proposals are in-eligible proposals due to various reasons. The presentation of these eligible & in-eligible proposals were made before IMAC one by one for consideration and approval by the IMAC. Project-wise details placed at **Annexure-II**.

7. Thereafter, 24 proposals received against the EoI dated 29.12.2017 received in the month of January, February and March, 2018 as provided on **Annexure -III** were taken up one by one for consideration and approval by the IMAC. The shortcomings in the ineligible proposals also brought to the notice of the applicants present during the meeting and provided them appropriate suggestions on their proposals.

Meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.
