Minutes of meeting of Inter-Ministerial Approval Committee (IMAC) for the Scheme for Integrated Cold Chain and Value Addition Infrastructure held on 20.01.2021

A meeting of Inter-Ministerial Approval Committee (IMAC) constituted under Scheme for Integrated Cold Chain and Value Addition Infrastructure was held on 20.01.2021, through Video Conference, under the Chairpersonship of Hon'ble Minister of State, FPI.

At the outset, Joint Secretary and Convener of IMAC welcomed the Minister of State, FPI and other members of the Committee. IMAC discussed and deliberated each agenda item. Following decisions were taken: -

1. New Proposals

1.1 Agenda Item No. 1: Raunak Deshlahra, Rajnandgaon, Chhatisgarh.

Technical Committee observations and recommendation dated 24.12.2020:

Observations:

- a) The applicant has applied under General category. However, the scheme is open only for SC/ST/NER category.
- b) The applicant has uploaded the expired copy of demand draft dated 26.06.2020 of ₹10,000 from Central Bank of India. The same was valid for 3 months from the date of issue.
- c) The applicant has not uploaded the demand draft of ₹ 1,00,000. The applicant has uploaded the copy of expired demand draft of ₹ 10,000 instead of ₹ 1,00,000

Recommendation:

Technical Committee recommended the proposal to be placed before IMAC as in-eligible as the applicant has applied the proposal under General category. However, the scheme is open only for SC/ST/NER category.

2.3 Agenda Item No. 3: Request of promoter for revision of grant in aid and applying of cost norm of Utilities determined by Ministry on 29.07.2020 in respect of Integrated Cold Chain Project of M/s GRB Dairy Foods Private Limited, Dindigul, Tamil Nadu.

IMAC noted that the request of promoter has been considered in Technical Committee (TC) meeting held on 24.12.2020. Technical Committee (TC) recommended the downward revision of grant in aid from ₹653.35 lakhs to ₹650.98 lakh.

IMAC approved the downward revision of grant in aid from ₹653.35 lakhs to ₹650.98 lakh as recommended by TC.

IMAC approved the recommendation of the Technical Committee in respect of Integrated Cold Chain Project of M/s. PMD Milk and Foods, Pune, Maharashtra.

2.8 Agenda Item No. 8: Request of the promoter for change in lending bank from M/s. Yes Bank Limited to M/s. HDFC Bank Limited and extension of time upto 15.12.2020 for uploading of final documents pertaining to release of 1st instalment of grant in respect of Integrated Cold Chain Project M/s Sneha Farms Pvt. Ltd., Telangana.

IMAC noted that the proposal has been considered in Technical Committee meeting held on 24.12.2020. Technical Committee recommended the proposal to be placed before IMAC for consideration on the following:

- (a) Change of lending bank from M/s. Yes Bank Limited to M/s. HDFC Bank Limited.
- (b) Not to allow the relaxation in submission of DH location documents for release of 1st instalment of grant.

IMAC noted that the proposal has been considered in Technical Committee meeting held on 24.12.2020. Technical Committee recommended the proposal to be placed before IMAC for consideration of the following:

- (a) Not to accept the dropping of 3 reefer vehicles (out of earlier approved 4 nos) with reduction in capacity.

IMAC approved the recommendation of Technical Committee of not accepting the reduction in number and capacity of reefer vehicles in respect of Integrated Cold Chain Project of M/s. Royal Cold Chain, Navi Mumbai & Solapur, Maharashtra.

2.10 Agenda Item No. 10: Request of the promoter for considering water shower retort as eligible component for grant and accordingly revise the grant for the Integrated Cold Chain project of M/s. Naturade Foods Pvt. Ltd., Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh.

4. OTHER ADDITIONAL AGENDA

4.1 Agenda Item No. 1: Consideration on the CIM decision in respect of M/s. Ambrozia Frozen Foods, Panchkula, Haryana.

IMAC noted that the proposal has been considered by the Committee of Independent Monitors (CIM) on 16.12.2020 on the request of the promoter for re-consideration of decision of earlier IMAC dated 28.08.2020 that rejected the proposal on account of not fulfilling the requirements of clause 8 (a) & (i) of the scheme guidelines regarding net worth and Expansion / Upgradation of existing facility(ies) in the same premises.

Further, IMAC noted that the CIM has recommended to re-consider the decision of IMAC dated 28.08.2020 by considering the supplementary documents submitted towards the net worth calculation of the applicant and also the project may not be considered as "Expansion / Upgradation of existing facility(ies) in the same premises".

IMAC Observation:

IMAC noted that one out of four pages (pg. no. 3) in the net worth supporting land documents, for one of the partners, was missing in the documents uploaded at the time of application (EoI) and the complete scanned copy of the same has been submitted by the applicant after the Technical Committee and before the IMAC dated 28.08.2020. Further, IMAC also taken note of the observation of the CIM that the amounts and figures mentioned in the later submitted documents i.e. "valuation reports for the constructed buildings along with the sale deed mentioning the area of the land (in support of the earlier uploaded allotment letter for the purpose of calculation of net worth)", are same as the net worth amount mentioned in the uploaded CA certificate for the Net Worth.

IMAC Recommendation:

After detailed deliberations, IMAC considered the recommendation of CIM and approved the proposal as eligible.
