

**OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

**Subject: -Constituting a Committee of Independent Monitors for 'Mega Food Parks' and 'Cold Chain' Schemes of the Ministry.**

Ministry of Food Processing Industries is implementing the 'Scheme of Development of Infrastructure for Food Processing Industries' having components of 'Mega Food Parks' and 'Cold Chain, Value Addition & Preservation Infrastructure'. In these projects, the number of proposals received against 'expressions of interest' generally exceeds the number of slots available for approval.


2. In the guidelines of 'Mega Food Parks' issued on 10/02/2014 and guidelines of 'Cold Chain, Value Addition & Preservation Infrastructure' issued on 08/08/2014, the procedure of selection of beneficiary project for financial assistance envisages two-tier evaluation, first by the Programme Management Agency and thereafter by a Technical Committee. The recommendations of the Technical Committee are considered by the Inter-Ministerial Approval Committee (IMAC). Recommendations of the IMAC are placed before the Minister (FPI) for approval. Only after the approval of IMAC's recommendations by the Minister, sanction to the projects is to be issued.

3. The Applicants whose proposals have not been recommended by the IMAC, will be given an opportunity to submit a representation, within 15 days from the date of posting of the IMAC's recommendations on the website of the Ministry.

4. To provide a window for redressal of grievances, the Ministry has appointed a Committee of three Independent Monitors to examine representations against the selection of the projects as in para (2) above.

5. The guidelines for Redressal of such grievances will be as follows:-

- (i) The recommendations of IMAC will be placed on website of the Ministry.
- (ii) The Applicant(s) may, within 15 (fifteen) days of posting of such recommendation of IMAC on the website of the Ministry, submit a representation against non-selection of a project, by e-mail to the Deputy Secretary (Grievance) whose contact details and email id will be notified on website. He will forward the same to the Committee of Independent Monitors (CIM).


  
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- (iii) The Committee may call for the relevant records of the case from the concerned Division. The records will be provided by the concerned Division within 3 (three) working days.
- (iv) The Committee will examine the records of the case within 15 days of the receipt of reference from Ministry. The Committee will have the discretion of providing an opportunity for personal hearing, on the request from applicant. Notice for such hearing will be sent by email.
- (v) In case the applicant does not turn up for personal hearing on the given date, the Committee may give ex-parte findings on the representation.
- (vi) The Committee will submit their findings to the Minister (FPI) within 21 days of receipt of reference from Ministry.
- (vii) In case, the Committee differs with the recommendations of IMAC, the matter will be reviewed by the Committee jointly with the Ministry and findings of such joint review will be submitted to the Minister for decision. The decision of the Minister will be final and will be placed on the website of the Ministry and also conveyed to the applicant.

6. The opportunity to submit the representation will be available only against the non-selection of the projects of the applicant. This mechanism will not be available during the implementation phase of the projects.

7. In case, the representation is found to be frivolous by Independent Monitors; penalty of Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rs. one Lakh only) will be imposed on the applicant, which will be deducted from the EMD deposited with application.

8. The concerned Division of the Ministry will provide secretarial assistance to the Independent Monitors of MoFPI for the above purpose. The Committee will conduct its proceedings at the place provided by the Ministry in its premises.
