**Gist of decisions taken by the Inter Ministerial Approval Committee (IMAC) constituted under the scheme of Cold Chain, Value Addition and Preservation Infrastructure in its meeting held on 23.09.2016**

1	Action Taken Note (ATN) on the Minutes of IMAC Meeting held on 04.08.2016	IMAC noted the actions taken on the decision of the IMAC in its meeting held on 04.08.2016.
2	Change in lending bank and recalculation of grant in respect of integrated cold chain project of M/s Neutrons Agri Produce, Udham Singh Nagar, Uttarakhand.	IMAC approved the change in lending bank from Punjab National Bank to Bank of Baroda. However, IMAC did not accede to the request of the promoter for re-calculation of the grant.
3	Issue of approval letter to M/s Rishi Ice and Cold Pvt. Ltd., Maharashtra.	IMAC decided that the cost of Technical Civil Work (TCW) for collection centre and sorting grading hall amounting to Rs. 622.20 lakh may not be considered eligible for grant calculation as this is an expansion project and collection centre and grading packing hall has been envisaged at ground level and at basement, respectively of the existing building in which distribution hub is also setup. However, the IMAC approved the total eligible cost of Rs. 18.78 lakh towards Plant & Machinery comprising of SS tables, sorting grading conveyor and weighing scale. IMAC approved the final eligible grant of Rs. 829.09 lakh.
4	Extension of time for submission of documents for release of 1 <sup>st</sup> installment of grant in respect of M/s Scasa Industries, Ludhiana, Punjab.	IMAC decided not to accede to the request for extension of timelines for project implementation due to inordinate delays in the project take off and cancelled the project.
5	Proposal of M/s Aligned Industries, Haryana – for condoning delay in submission of documents for	IMAC took note of the agenda item and decided to condone the delay in submission of documents for release of 3 <sup>rd</sup> and final

6	M/s MKC Agro Fresh Ltd., Uttar Pradesh – approval for change in means of finance.	IMAC has approved the revised/actual means of finance for the project.
7	Case of M/s FIL Industries Ltd., Jammu & Kashmir for consideration of release of 3 <sup>rd</sup> & final installment of grant	IMAC decided that a Committee comprising of JS(Finance), DS(AN) and representative of PMA may discuss and identify those indigenously added components which are essential for the sorting/grading line, the status of suppliers from whom these items have been secured and the admissibility of eligible grant-in-aid for the project. The Committee will submit its recommendations to be placed before the IMAC in the next meeting.

IMAC approved the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) Condoned the delay in submission of documents for release of 3<sup>rd</sup> and final installment of grant;</li> <li>b) Change of locations of 7 BMCs; taking into record final locations of all 15 BMCs and 5 sales outlets and considering all 15 BMCs and 5 sales outlets as eligible for calculation of grant-in-aid; and</li> <li>c) Reduction in eligible grant from Rs. 902.003 lakh to Rs. 758.01 lakhs.</li> </ul>
9	Continuance or otherwise of the approval granted to the integrated cold chain project of M/s Apollo Agro Industries Limited, Mehsana, Gujarat for setting up irradiation facilities	IMAC observed that the project had undergone change in capacity, location, project cost and means of finance making it a new project vis-à-vis what was submitted by the promoter against EOI dated 02.12.2013. IMAC decided not to accede to the request for extension of timelines for project implementation due to inordinate delays in the project take off and cancelled the project.



10	Supreme Agro Foods Pvt. Ltd., Punjab for change in location of BMCs and reduction in approved grant	IMAC approved the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) Change of locations of 11 BMCs and taking into record final locations of 74 BMCs as given by the promoter duly certified by CE (Mech) and considering all 74 BMCs as eligible for calculation of grant-in-aid.</li> <li>b) Reduction in eligible grant from Rs. 891.325 lakh to Rs. 806.53 lakhs</li> <li>c) Final project cost and means of finance for the project as given below:</li> </ul>
11	M/s Elaf Cold Storage, Panvel, Raigad, Maharashtra – reduction in grant-in-aid	IMAC ratified the downward revision of grant from Rs. 762.27 lakh to 715.95 lakh in case of M/s Elaf Cold Storage.
