**Ministry of Food Processing Industries- Report for July, 2019**

**1.0 Important policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:**

**1.1 Important policy decision taken during the month:**

- a. 100 days Action Plan of the Ministry was finalised.
- b. A policy decision was taken to mandate a uniform 'Branding Board' at all locations of projects that receive financial assistance from the Ministry.

**1.2 Major achievements during the month:**

**A. Operation Greens:**

- a. 3<sup>rd</sup> Inter-Ministerial Committee (IMAC) chaired by Hon'ble Minister, FPI was held on 03.07.2019 for considering the recommendations of Mission Operation Greens on the 10 proposals received under Operation Greens Scheme.
- b. A meeting was held on 23.07.2019 under chairmanship of Joint Secretary, FPI with all PMAs working for different schemes under the Ministry, Division heads of the schemes and representative of Cost Norm Committee, headed by NIFTEM to discuss the cost norms for processing facilities for TOP crops.

**B. Cold Chain Scheme:**

- a. Inter-Ministerial Approval Committee (IMAC) chaired by Hon'ble Minister, FPI was held on 02.07.2019 for considering the project proposals and 10 projects were sanctioned with an outlay of Rs.291.38 crores and grant-in-aid of Rs.66.68 crores.

b. During this month, under the scheme of Integrated Cold Chain & Value Addition Infrastructure of PMKSY Nine (9) cold chain projects have reported completion and start of commercial operations. Total no. of projects completed under the scheme is 163.

**C. Mega Food Park:**

a. A review meeting chaired by Hon'ble Minister, FPI held on 11.07.2019 to review the progress of implementation of Mega Food Parks.

b. An RFP has been issued on 25.07.2019 for "Evaluation of the Impact of the Scheme for Mega Food Park" with last date of submission as 23.08.2019.

**D. Creation/Expansion of Food Processing and Preservation Capacities (Unit Scheme):**

a. Inter-Ministerial Approval Committee chaired by Hon'ble Minister, FPI held on 12.07.2019 for considering the proposals received for CEFPPC under Pradhan Mantri Kisan Sampada Yojana and approved 8 food processing units in various states of the country. These projects will leverage Rs. 111.06 crore of investment and involve subsidy outgo of Rs. 35.38 crore. Cumulative investment leveraged under the Scheme till date is Rs. 1992.27 crore. Total no. of projects completed under the scheme are 5.

**E. Scheme for Agro-Processing Clusters (APC):**

a. Inter-Ministerial Approval Committee chaired by Hon'ble Minister, FPI held on 22.07.2019 for considering the proposals received for APC under Pradhan Mantri Kisan Sampada Yojana and it approved 4 Agro Processing Clusters in various states of the country. These projects will leverage Rs. 88.789 crore of investment and involve subsidy outgo of Rs. 34.51 crore. Cumulative investment leveraged under the Scheme till date is Rs. 873.40 crore.

**F. IIFPT:**

- a. IIFPT organized 'National Seminar on Advances in Bulk Grain Storage & Smart Sensor and IoT Applications in Warehouses at Thanjavur on 26.07.2019.

**G. NIFTEM:**

- a. 30<sup>th</sup> Board of Management meeting was held on 10.07.2019 at NIFTEM.
- b. 19<sup>th</sup> Meeting of Academic Council was held on 03.07.2019 at NIFTEM.

**1.3 Foreign visit of Hon'ble Minister, FPI and foreign delegation to MoFPI:**

- a. A business delegation from South Africa met Joint Secretary, FPI on 16.07.2019 to discuss issues of mutual interest.
- b. A delegation from UAE met Joint Secretary, FPI on 18.07.2019 to discuss World Food India 2019 and other bilateral issues.
- c. A bilateral meeting between Hon'ble Minister, FPI and Mr. Luis Etchevehere, Secretary of Government for Agro-industry of Argentina was held on 18.07.2019.
- d. Mr. Richard Heald, CEO, UK India Business Council met Minister, FPI on 22.07.2019.
