

Ref. notification dated 22.09.2017 reg. modifications of guidelines of CEFPPC scheme.

Q.1- What is the meaning of “Creation/Expansion” under the scheme of CEFPPC?

Ans.- “Creation” means establishment/ setting up of the new unit in the Mega Food Park or in those States/UTs where there is no Mega Food Park assisted by the MoFPI, Whereas the **“Expansion”** means technological upgradation or inclusion of the new processing sector/ activities (as provided under the guidelines of the scheme) or enhancement of the processing/ preservation capacities in the existing units located in the Mega Food Parks or in the States/UTs where there is no Mega Food Park assisted by the MoFPI.

Q.2- Since only new units will be allotted in the MFP, whether the expansion of projects in the MFP will be considered?

Ans. Expansion of projects in the MFP also will be considered provided in such cases the project (s) should have achieved completion and commenced commercial operation/ production and successfully completed at least one year before the date of advertisement of EoI of this scheme. (Para 9 (i) g may be referred)

Q.3- Those applicants who have already uploaded their online applications till 22.09.2017 as per the guidelines notified on 12.07.2017, whether these applications will be considered or not?

Ans- Those proposals will be examined for their eligibility as per the notification of the modification in guidelines published on 22.09.2017.

Q.4- If the existing unit of F&VP processing at Jalandhar having capacity 20 MT per day is expanding/ upgrading its unit upto 50MT capacity per day at Moga. Whether it will be considered as expansion/ up-gradation of existing unit or it is new unit to be set up at different location.

Ans- Expansion/ up-gradation of the unit mean expansion/ up-gradation of the existing unit at the same location.

Q.5- We have applied for the plot in MFP and paid 10% advance for allotment of plot in MFP, whether the same will suffice the purpose to be eligible for consideration of our proposal in MFP under CEFPPC scheme?

Ans.- No. The unit promoter under the scheme must have purchased or own land on lease/ rental basis for setting up its unit in the Mega Food Park assisted by MoFPI.

Q-6- In our State, though the MFP approved by the MoFPI is available but there is no required infrastructure available as on date to set up FP unit there. In such cases whether the same consideration will be given to those proposals as considered for the proposals in the State/UTs that do not have MFP?

Ans - No.
